## Joint Intersex NGO Oral Statement CEDAW71 Nepal, 22.10.2018 Esan Regmi, Parsu Ram Rai (Blue Diamond Society, Nepal) and StopIGM.org Presented by Daniela Truffer (StopIGM.org)

Thank you.

I'm an intersex person speaking on behalf of my Nepali peers who can't afford travelling to Geneva.

As shown in our Joint NGO report, intersex genital mutilation remains a growing practice in Nepal, including partial clitoris amputation.

**Infanticide** and **child abandonment** are frequent. There are reports of **expulsion of adolescents from their families**, of **forced marriage** to avoid conspicuousness, of **bullying and abuse** preventing intersex children from attending school.

In 2016, CRC urged Nepal to eliminate harmful practices on intersex children.<sup>2</sup> To this day the **State party fails to act**. Also in its replies to the LOI, Nepal simply **ignored the questions on intersex**.<sup>3</sup>

Intersex people demand **protection from harmful practices**<sup>4</sup> and the full enjoyment of human rights.
